### **Places to Visit in Aurangabad**



Ajanta Caves - 29 rock-cut Buddhist cave monuments which date from the 2nd century BCE to about 480 or 650 CE, its paintings and rock cut sculptures are described as among the finest surviving examples of ancient Indian art, particularly expressive paintings that present emotion through gesture, pose and form. Distance (Aurangabad to Ajanta Caves): 2 h 8 min (96.8 km) via Aurangabad - Ajanta Jalgaon Rd; Timing: 9 am to 9:30 pm (Monday Closed)



Ellora Caves - It is one of the largest rock-cut monastery-temple cave complexes in the world and a UNESCO world Heritage Site, featuring Buddhist, Hindu and Jain monuments and art work, dating from the 600-1000 CE period. Distance (Aurangabad to Ellora Caves): 48 min (30.1 km) via NH52; Timing: Sunrise to Sunset (Monday Closed)



Daulatabad Fort - Daulatabad Fort, also known as Devagiri, is a town which includes the devagiri-daulatabad Fort. it is a 14th century fort city in Maharashtra. It is a located at about 16 kilometers (9.9 mi) northwest of Aurangabad. However, it is also considered to be one of the seven wonders of Maharashtra and a developing tourist spot.



Bibi Ka Maqbara - The city is known for the Bibi Ka Maqbara situated about 3 km (2 mi) from the city which is the burial mausoleum of Emperor Aurangzeb's wife, Dilras Banu Begum also Known as Rabia-ud-Daurani. It is an imitation of the Taj Mahal at Agra and due to its similar design, it is popularly known as the "Taj of the Deccan."



Panchakki - The 17th-Century water mill (Panchakki) situated at the distance of 1 km from the city is known for its underground watter channel, which traverses more than 8 km. To its Source away in the mountains. The channel culminates into an artificial waterfall that powers the mill.
